Glenn County Sheriff's Posse Primary Objectives and Purpose

- 1. The GCSP is organized to provide:**
 - A mounted unit for the Glen County Sheriff's Office for their use in Search & Rescue and other non-law enforcement duties.
 - An Honorary Color Guard for the Glenn County Sheriff's Department for public appearances and for other support activities as requested by the Sheriff's Department
- 2. To provide for an annual scholarship to Glenn County High School student and other donated funding to local High Schools as approved by the GCSP Board of Directors.**
- 3. Provide facilities for and conduct the following activities**
 - A junior Posse
 - Junior Rodeo Event
 - Annual Poker Ride
 - Monitor community events
 - Search & Rescue Training
 - 29 & Over Equestrian Fund Raiser
 - Maintain the GCSP Arena and Property
- 4. Members will agree to participate in the above activities as their commitments allow.**

GENERAL BEHAVIOR
