Membership Application Procedures

- 1. Prospective Member will Attend a Board of Directors meeting on the 1st Tuesday of the Month.**
 - An information sheet will be provided explaining the Posse's purpose and a member's responsibilities.**
 - A \$30.00 check, for dues, will be attached to the application from the prospective member. The \$30.00 is not refundable if the membership is declined.**
- 2. The application will be given to the membership chairperson. The chairperson(s) will schedule a home visit to interview the prospective member and make a report to the GCSP Board of Directors at the next meetin**
- 3. The chair person(s) will contact the Glenn County Sheriff's Office to schedule a Live Scan, (photograph & fingerprints) appointment and background check. The applicant will pay for these costs.**
- 4. The prospective members will be either accepted or denied membership based on their interview and background check.**
- 5. The new member will attend the next regularly scheduled general membership meeting, the 2nd Tuesday of the Month, to be introduced to fellow members.**
- 6. There is a 6-month probationary membership period for all new members.**
- 7. A new member will receive a copy of the GCSP's By-Laws and Code of Conduct.**
- 8. Members may, after the 6-month probation, pay the cost to receive a Posse badge. The badge is property of the Corporation and must be returned when membership is withdrawn or dropped.**
- 9. Posse dress, work, parade uniforms & tack are purchased at the members expense.**
