Membership Application Procedures

1. Attend a Board of Directors meeting on the 1st Tuesday of the month.
 - * An information sheet will be provided explaining the Posse's purpose and a member's responsibilities.
 - * A \$30.00 check, for dues, will be attached to the application from the prospective member. If membership is declined the check will be returned.
2. The application will be given to the membership chairperson. The chairperson(s) will contact the Glenn County Sheriff's Office to schedule a Live Scan (photograph & fingerprints) appointment and back ground check. The applicant will pay for these costs.
3. The chairperson(s) will schedule a home visit to interview the prospective member and make a report to the Board of Directors at the next meeting.
4. The prospective member will be either accepted or denied membership based upon their interview and background check.
5. The new member will attend the next regularly scheduled general membership meeting, the 2nd Tuesday of the month, to be introduced to fellow members.
6. There is a 6 month probationary membership period for all new members.
7. A new member will receive a copy of the GCSP's By-laws and Code of Conduct.
8. Members may, after the 6 month probation, pay the actual cost & administration fee to receive a Posse badge. The badge is the property of the Corporation and must be returned when membership is withdrawn or dropped.
9. Posse dress, work, parade uniforms & tack are purchased at the members own expense.

Glenn County Sheriff's Posse

Membership is open to all adult California residents without discrimination of any kind on the basis of sex, race, color, religion ancestry, national origin, marital status, disability, political affiliation or age.

Primary Objectives and Purposes

1. The GCSP is organized to provide:
 - * A mounted unit for the Sheriff's Office for their use in Search & Rescue and other non-law enforcement duties.
 - * An Honorary Color Guard for the Glenn County Sheriff's Department for public appearances and for other support activities as requested by the Sheriff's Department.
2. To provide for an annual scholarship to a Glenn County High School student and other donated funding to local High Schools as approved by the Board of Directors.
3. Provide facilities for and conduct the following activities:
 - A Junior Posse
 - Junior Rodeo Event
 - Equestrian events at the arena
 - Annual Poker Ride
 - Monitor community events
 - Search & Rescue Training
 - 29 and Over Equestrian Fundraiser
 - Maintain the arena & property
4. Members will agree to participate in the above activities as their commitments allow.

General Behavior

Members shall not act or behave privately or officially in such a manner as to bring discredit upon the GCSP members or the Sheriff's Department. Members will not willfully violate any Federal Statute, State law, or local ordinances. Each member must be aware that they are constantly in the public eye and should behave accordingly. Members will follow the Glenn County Sheriff's Posse By-laws and Code of Conduct rules.
